



## CONSTITUTION FOR VEHICLES ON RMS CONDITIONAL REGISTRATIONS- 60 DAY LOGBOOK SCHEMES

Please note that members joining Bathurst Light Car Club on or after 13<sup>th</sup> June 2018 will be required to be a financial member of the club for a period of 12 months from membership approval date, before access to the privilege of accessing the Historic or Conditional Registration Scheme through BLCC will be approved. Retention of the privilege after that date, once granted, will require those members to contribute to the club activities by one or more of the following requirements.

- i) Attend at least 3 General Meetings each calendar year.
- ii) Participate in an event conducted by the club during each calendar year to qualify for the forthcoming years eligibility.
- iii) Volunteer and be prepared to assist as a marshal or some other function in support of events conducted by BLCC on Mt Panorama or at The Quarry during each calendar year to qualify for the forthcoming years eligibility.

### PART 1 – GENERAL

This document forms the rules and regulations/conditions of The Bathurst Light Car Club. (to be known herein as the BLCC) regarding the 60 Day Log Booked Historic and or CVS Conditional Registration concession schemes allowed to financial members of a designated Motor Club by the Road & Maritime Services of NSW (RMS).

The BLCC committee shall appoint a member of the Club as a Registrar for administration of these schemes.

The Registrar shall maintain a record/register of each member holding plates, the plate/s details together with details of relative vehicle to which that plate is held against/relates to. Completion of the vehicle usage log shall be the sole responsibility of the member in each instance and is to be **completed in ink in log book prior to commencement of each days usage/ journey** as required by RMS. (1 Entry per day for each driver)

Registration of your vehicle under the relative scheme nominating BLCC as primary Club will indicate and imply your acceptance of the conditions required to be complied with by you as a member of BLCC as specified hereunder.

### PART 2 – ELIGIBILITY

- (a) All vehicles must be a minimum of 30 years old from date of manufacture, the onus of proof of age shall be with the applicant for Conditional Registration. However the final arbiter shall be the Club Plate Registrar .
- (b) All vehicles must comply with registration requirements in country of origin in year of manufacture and in NSW. The vehicle must be maintained in a roadworthy condition at all times when being driven on public roads and comply with relative RMS regulations.
- (c) Conditional Registration applications will only be considered from vehicle owners who are active financial members of the BLCC who have been a full financial member for 12 months prior to making application, reside in NSW and whose subject vehicle is/will be garaged in

NSW.

- (d) All applicants for Conditional Registration shall be handed a copy of these Regulations and Rules. Applicants shall read and sign the BLCC form attached acknowledging the fact that they fully understand their responsibilities and agree to abide by these regulations whilst plates are held. This acknowledgement is to be completed before Conditional Registration Application will be approved and signed off by the Club Plate Registrar (BLCC).

### PART 3 – AUTHORISED USAGE

- (a) Vehicles covered under the 60 Day Logbook Conditional Registration Scheme shall /may be used for up to 60 separate calendar days as recorded in advance (in ink) in the respective log books. This use is in addition and further to any Club events specifically identified in the official club calendar of acknowledged events and as detailed also in the monthly Blower Magazine. Details of events are on club website (subsection "b" hereunder). A second calendar in instances of 2 clubs being nominated at registration may be utilised also ***No other use is permitted.***
- (b) Club events shall be but not limited to:
- i events as set out in the BLCC events calendar, including displays for Club promotional purposes agreed to by the Club Committee;
  - ii events conducted by other motoring clubs or organisations to which an official invitation has been received by and accepted by the BLCC and advised/communicated to Club members;
  - iii special events for charities and community bodies to which an official invitation or request to attend is received by the Club Committee and communicated to members;
  - iv official events of other clubs to which particular members of our club have been invited. Such events must be listed in our Calendar of Events Register on website.
  - v When attending any such events a copy of downloaded/Blower and or communication detailing the events in the club calendar should be carried so as to minimise issues and or resolve queries with police in the event of an incident or questioning with regards to usage.
- (c) **Servicing of Vehicles:** (Forms part of Private use now-not an extra)  
Journeys necessary for the servicing or road testing of vehicles fall within and forms part of the 60 Days "Log Book" usage as designated in the RMS log book usage description.

### PART 4 – RESPONSIBILITY OF CONDITIONAL REGISTRATION HOLDERS

- (a) All initial enquiries should be directed to the BLCC Plates Registrar. Individual approaches to the RMS are not encouraged except for attending to initial registration processes (once signed off by BLCC Registrar) and subsequent annual renewals (also after sign off and stamping by Registrar). This practice is twofold in that it keeps BLCC records up to date and provides capacity for BLCC to disseminate information direct to members in relation to any scheme updates/changes. RMS Forms must be stamped by BLCC Registrar each year for renewals after initial registration process. A copy of registration/certificate of operation is to be delivered to the Plates Registrar each year upon renewal.

- (b) Plates are issued to a member of the BLCC Inc. and are not transferable either to another vehicle or to another person in the event of the vehicle being disposed of by the member- this also excludes transfer to other club members.
- (c) Plates must be immediately returned to the RMS.
  - i in the event of the sale of the vehicle on which they are issued;
  - ii upon the member's resignation from the Club;
  - iii upon the member's failure to remain a financial member within the meaning of the constitution of the Club or on failure to pay any levy that may be constitutionally approved by a duly constituted Club Meeting; Membership must be up to date on the 1<sup>st</sup> January each calendar year otherwise vehicle is not technically registered for purpose of use on the road and thereby not covered by CTP and other insurances.
  - iv at the directive of a Club Committee decision. Particularly concerning any actions deemed prejudicial to the good name and standing of the BLCC;
  - v if the Club Registrar considers the vehicle has been made unsafe or altered after it has been initially inspected and passed.
- (d) Conditional Registration is issued on the understanding that the member's prime intended use is in accordance with these conditions and not in a manner that would bring disrepute to BLCC in event of incident or unauthorised use.
- (e) Registered vehicle are for social/domestic use only and not to be used as trade/work vehicles with all usage to be entered as prescribed in log books and as required prior to commencement of the days activity.

NOTE:

Failure to return Plates upon request may//will result in notification to the Police and/or RMS that an unregistered vehicle may be being used from your address. Plates always remain property of RMS.

**PART 5 – ANNUAL VEHICLE INSPECTION**

- (a) Please note that the RMS will issue renewals for Conditional Registration through the mail as with normal vehicle registration. NB- **All renewal applications must be signed off and stamped by the Club Plate Registrar to facilitate your renewal- required by RMS.**
- (b) Each year, you will receive from the RMS your renewal documents. Please co-operate by attending to and paying same within the prescribed time frame and by due date. Failure to comply may result in renewal being denied/refused.
- (c) You are required to obtain and present a" pink slip" for process to registrar in advance.
- (d) No member will be issued with Conditional Registration or renewal if that member's vehicle is found not to be roadworthy or is ineligible or modified further to original condition of vehicle at presentation for initial registration.
- (e) Chassis and engine numbers will form part of the identification of a vehicle issued with Conditional Registration – any change must be notified in writing to the Club Plates Registrar in addition to advice to RMS.
- (f) Please ensure you notify any change of your postal address or place where your car is garaged both to RMS and Club Plates Registrars.(Refer website for detail)

## PART 6 – INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

A minimum insurance cover of Third Party Property Insurance is recommended for your own protection. It is strongly recommended that full comprehensive insurance be obtained as a policy on an eligible “Conditionally Registered “vehicle is approximately the same cost as Third Party Property Insurance.

## SUPPLEMENT

As the issue of these plates is a concession from the RMS in conjunction with BLCC, applicants are advised to read the attached Rules carefully and at all times comply with their directives. Bear in mind any transgressions could bring the Club into disrepute.

In addition, please note that any car driven on a public road must be properly silenced with a muffler suitable/compliant for road use.

Numberplates issued by the RMS must be attached to both the front and rear of the vehicle at all times whilst being driven on the road.

Please remember that if any use is not “Authorised Use” (ref. Section 3) then the vehicle at the time is not legally covered by the scheme. Owner would/may be denied any insurance cover irrespective of whether CTP, Third Party Property or Comprehensive policies.

(This also applies if you cease to be a financial member of the BLCC – current financial status must be retained at all times as it forms part of your registration.)
