1. **Organising Club:** Bathurst Light Car Club
2. **Authority** The event will be a **National Championship Hill Climb** (herein after referred to as “The Event”) and will be conducted under the provisions of the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices and the National Competition Rules (NCR) of CAMS, the Speed Event Standing Regulations, the Australian Hill Climb Championship Sporting Regulations, the CAMS Motor Sport Passenger Ride Activity (MSPRA) Policy, these Supplementary Regulations and any Further Regulations or bulletins which may be issued. This Event will be conducted under and in accordance with CAMS OH&S, CAMS Safety 1st and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the CAMS website at www.cams.com.au.
3. The event will be conducted under **CAMS Permit No: 819/0311/01** which will be displayed at the start of the event.
4. The event will be the CAMS Australian Hill Climb Championship and will be conducted on Mountain Straight, Mt Panorama racing circuit which is situated approximately 5 kms from Bathurst. The course is 1710 metres in length. The event will be organised and promoted by BLCC and a committee consisting of Scott Sims, Kathy Hanrahan, Tony Hanrahan, Michael Williamson, Phil Burgett.

8. Eligible Vehicles

As per Article 5 – Eligible Vehicles of the Australian Hill Climb Championship Sporting Regulations.

9. Event Schedule:

- a) Thursday 31st October 2019 - Scrutineering
- b) Friday 1st November 2019 - Scrutineering & Practice
- c) Saturday 2nd November 2019 - Scrutineering

- d) Sunday 3rd November 2019 - Scrutineering
Official Runs
- e) There will be 6 Official runs (3 runs Saturday 2nd November, 2019, 3 runs Sunday 3rd November, 2019)

10. **Tyre Warming:** As per Australian Hill Climb Championship Sporting Regulations, Article 12 – Tyre Warming.

11. Scrutineering Requirements:

Targeted Scrutiny will be available at this meeting for log book vehicles in the Targeted Scrutiny system. The Chief Scrutineer for the event will determine which vehicles are to be audited and those competitors will be advised a time at which the audit will occur at event documentation checking

- a) Vehicles must comply with Schedules A and B of the CAMS General Requirements for Automobiles (as specified in the CAMS Manual).
- b) Competitors' permanent competition numbers will be accepted wherever possible. The order of receipt of entry will determine the allocation of numbers for duplicate application for numbers, the exception being number one which is automatically allocated to the reigning CAMS Australian Hill Climb Champion only. Competitors must supply their own Competition Numbers which must comply with the Schedule K of the CAMS Manual and are to be positioned on BOTH SIDES of the vehicle and must be of a contrasting colour to the surrounding bodywork.
- c) All Drivers' apparel (helmets, overalls, etc.) must comply with Schedule D of the CAMS Manual and be presented for inspection and approval. All Drivers must be attired from neck to ankle, with long sleeves. Flammable synthetic material (e.g. Nylon) is not acceptable. Foot wear must be fully enclosed, and minimum of leather uppers. Nylon runners or gym shoes are NOT permitted.
- d) **Safety Belt/Harness & Roll Bars/Cage** must be in accordance with Schedule I and Schedule J of the CAMS Manual.

- e) Drivers of open cars must wear **Goggles or visors** with a lens of material **other than glass**. Goggles fitted with laminated or triplex glass are **absolutely forbidden**. Refer Schedule D of the CAMS Manual.
- f) All vehicles must be fitted with a **Fire Extinguisher** conforming to CAMS Manual Schedule H.
- g) All competitors are permitted to use any fuel defined in Schedule G of the CAMS Manual. **Vehicles running on alcohol** must be so marked by the letter “**A**” in white on a red circle approximately 115mm in diameter (with a white border), placed adjacent to the competition number on each side of the car and next to the fuel filler cap. The use of **Nitrous oxide is prohibited** in all categories.
- h) **Fuel** may be sampled and tested by the Organisers for all categories except Fifth Category vehicles using alcohol. It will be the competitor’s responsibility to ensure his/her car is made available for this when and if required.
- i) Vehicles must conform to the minimum weight requirements as per Category and CAMS requirements. Facilities will be available to carry out weighing of vehicles and it will be the competitor’s responsibility to ensure his/her car is made available for this when and if required.
- j) **Bonnets** must be fitted with two independent fastening systems of limited extensibility in accordance with Schedule B of the CAMS Manual.
- k) Vehicles with other than closed circuit breathing must be fitted with an **oil trap container** of 2 litres capacity for engines up to 2000cc and 3 litres capacity if over 2000cc with the exception of cars registered for road use.
- l) **Oil Drain Plugs** must be securely wired, with the exception of cars registered for road use.
- m) All formula cars employing a battery electrical system must be provided with either an automatic or manually operated **Battery Circuit Breaker or Isolating Switch in accordance with CAMS regulations**.
- n) **Blue Battery Location Triangle** (as per CAMS Manual) must be fitted to all cars.
- o) **An Efficient Muffler must be fitted to all vehicles** and a noise meter may be in operation. Competitors are reminded that **ALL** cars must be configured so that, when measured in competition conditions at 30m from the track edge, the sound emission from the vehicle does not exceed 95 db (A). Any car found to exceed the maximum noise emission limit will be suspended from the event until the Chief Scrutineer/Clerk of Course is satisfied that action has been taken to bring it within the limit.
- p) **Tyres** must comply with Schedule E of the CAMS Manual
- q) CAMS logo- All competing vehicles (with the exception of Historic vehicles) are required to display two CAMS Logo decals. Such decals will be available from the Promoters of the Event if required.
- r) It is compulsory for all competitors (excluding 5th Category cars) to prominently display the sponsors logo, which will be provided by the organisers, on either side of the vehicle adjacent to or above the competition no (if possible). This will be a maximum size of 450 x 120mm.
- s) Competitors and vehicles must be presented in a neat and tidy manner and comply with the regulations relevant to the class for which it is entered.
- t) The event will not be delayed due to late arrivals. It is the competitors’ responsibility to ensure their vehicles are scrutineered before the scheduled starting time of the event.
- u) Vehicles must be the subject of a current CAMS Log Book as required and in accordance with Schedule L of the CAMS Manual which must be produced at scrutineering.

v) All scrutiny to take place in the Pit area, McPhillamy Park, Mount Panorama. An extension of scrutiny times is at the sole discretion of the Clerk of Course and Chief Scrutineer and must be notified in writing to the Secretary.

13. Driver's Briefing: It is compulsory for all drivers to attend the Driver's Briefing prior to each days practice or competition. A Drivers' Briefing Attendance sheet must be signed by competitors each day at the Briefing. Failure to attend Drivers' Briefing will incur a \$50.00 fine for each non-attendance unless negated by the Stewards in exceptional circumstances. Scrutineering is to cease whilst the Drivers' Briefing is in progress.

16. Timing equipment & accuracy: Electronic timing accurate to 1/100th second.

17. Re-Runs: in accordance with Article 13 – Re-Runs of the Australian Hill Climb Championship Sporting Regulations.

18. Awards: Awards in the form of trophies and prize money to a minimum of the amount prescribed in the Australian Hill Climb Championship Sporting Regulations will be presented to successful competitors. Final allocation of trophies and prize money will be notified to competitors in the event Further Regulations. **The Australian Hill Climb Champion will be awarded as per the Australian Hill Climb Championship Sporting Regulations.** Awards will be presented at a function on Sunday 3rd November 2019 following the day's competition.

19. Authority of Officials: Any driver not following a reasonable instruction by an official during the event may be disqualified.

20. Medical facilities: Provided by Beneficial Safety

21. Venue Admittance Tickets: One Competitor's Pass and two Pit Passes will be supplied to each competitor with Further Supplementary Regulations.

22. Licences: The event will be open to driver's who hold a minimum of a CAMS Speed licence or Junior Speed Licence.

23. Insurance: Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by CAMS in relation to the Event. Further details can be found in the CAMS Insurance Handbook, available at www.cams.com.au.

- 24. Protests:** Any protests must be made in accordance with Part XII of the NCR.
- 25. Postponement/Abandonment/Cancellation:** The Organisers reserve the right to postpone, abandon or cancel the event in accordance with NCR 59.
- 26. ALCOHOL, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES:** Any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty(ies) for a breach in accordance with the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy and/or the CAMS Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy as published on the CAMS website. Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day. Accordingly, any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may also be tested for the presence of alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the CAMS Standard Operating Procedure for Breath Alcohol Testing.
- 27. Refreshment facilities:** Available in the pit area.
- 28.** Vehicles will be called to the start in **STRICT PROGRAMME GROUP ORDER** and if not present by the end of the appropriate category will miss that run.
- 29. The Organisers anticipate the following Classes for competition will be:**
- (a) If fewer than three (3) automobiles are entered in a class the organiser may, at their discretion, amalgamate only the displacement classes within that category.
- (b) The event organiser may invite additional classes not listed below.

 - motor vehicles (or parts of them) colliding with other motor vehicles or persons or property;
 - others participants acting dangerously or with lack of skills;
 - high levels of noise exposure;
 - acts of violence and other harmful acts (whether intentional or inadvertent) committed by persons attending or participating in the event; and
 - the failure or unsuitability of facilities (including grand-stands, fences and guard rails) to ensure my safety.

EXCLUSION OF LIABILITY, RELEASE & INDEMNITY

In exchange for being able to attend or participate in the Motor Sport Activities, I **agree**:

- to **release** CAMS and the Entities to the extent that any or all of them are providing Recreational Services from all liability for:
 - a) my **death**;
 - b) any **physical or mental injury** (including the aggravation, acceleration or recurrence of such an injury);
 - c) the contraction, aggravation or acceleration of a **disease**;
 - d) the coming into existence, the aggravation, acceleration or recurrence of any other **condition, circumstance, occurrence, activity, form of behaviour, course of conduct or state of affairs**:
 - i. that is or may be harmful or disadvantageous to me or the community;
 - ii. that may result in harm or disadvantage to me or the community, howsoever arising from my participation in or attendance at the Motor Sport Activities;
- to **indemnify and hold harmless and keep indemnified** the Entities to the maximum extent permitted by law in respect of any Claim by any person; and
- to attend at or participate in the Motor Sport Activities **at my own risk**. I **understand** that:
 - nothing in this document excludes, restricts or modifies any rights that I may have as a result of significant personal injury that is caused by the Reckless Conduct of the Entities as the supplier of the Motor Sport Activities / Recreational Services;
 - nothing in this document prevents the Entities from relying on any laws (including statute and common law) that limit or preclude their liability;
 - nothing in this document excludes any term or guarantee which under statute cannot be excluded; however the liability of the Entities is limited to the minimum liability allowable by law;
 - nothing in this document precludes me from making a claim under a CAMS insurance policy where I am expressly entitled to make a claim under that insurance policy; and
 - CAMS has arranged some limited personal injury insurance coverage which may provide me with some protection for loss, damage or injury that I may suffer during my participation in the Motor Sport Activities. However, I acknowledge and accept that the insurance taken out by CAMS may not provide me with full indemnity for loss, damage or injury that I may suffer during my participation in the Motor Sport Activities, and that I may have to pay the excess if a Claim is made under an insurance policy on my behalf. I agree that my own insurance arrangements are ultimately my responsibility and I will arrange any additional coverage at my expense after taking into account CAMS insurance arrangements, this document and my own circumstances.

Where Motor Sport Activities are held in the following jurisdictions, I acknowledge that I have also read and accept the following warnings:

WARNING APPLICABLE IN RELATION TO MOTOR SPORT ACTIVITIES HELD IN VICTORIA WARNING UNDER THE AUSTRALIAN CONSUMER LAW AND FAIR TRADING ACT 2012:

Under the Australian Consumer Law (Victoria), several statutory guarantees apply to the supply of certain goods and services. These guarantees mean that the supplier named on this form is required to ensure that the recreational services it supplies to you:

- are rendered with due care and skill;
- are reasonably fit for any purpose which you either expressly or by implication, make known to the supplier; and
- might reasonably be expected to achieve any result you have made known to the supplier.

Under section 22 of the **Australian Consumer Law and Fair Trading Act 2012 (Vic)**, the supplier is entitled to ask you to agree

that these conditions do not apply to you. If you sign this form, you will be agreeing that your rights to sue the supplier under the **Australian Consumer Law and Fair Trading Act 2012** if you are killed or injured because the services were not in accordance with these guarantees, are excluded, restricted or modified in the way set out in this form.

- "CAMS" means the Confederation of Australia Motor Sport Ltd.
- "Claim" means and includes any action, suit, proceeding, claim, demand or cause of action however arising including but not limited to negligence, BUT does **NOT** include a claim under a CAMS insurance policy by any person expressly entitled to make a claim under that insurance policy;
- "Entities" means event and competition organisers/promoters/managers, land and track owners/managers/administrators/lessees, CAMS affiliated clubs, state and territory governments and insured listed in CAMS' public/product/professional indemnity insurance policies **and** each of their related bodies corporate (including their related bodies corporate) **and** each of their organs and agencies, officers/president/directors/executives, employees, servants, agents, partners, providers, members, competitors, drivers, co-drivers, navigators, officials, crew members, pit crew, delegates, licence holders, representatives, commissions, committees, advisers, trustees, councils, panels, shareholders, volunteers, officials, appointees, delegated bodies and sponsors.
- "Motor Sport Activities" means any motor sport activities or Recreational Services which are permitted or approved which CAMS regulates or administers by CAMS or otherwise under the responsibility / control of CAMS;
- "Reckless Conduct" means conduct where the supplier of the recreational services is aware, or should reasonably have been aware, of a significant risk that the conduct could result in personal injury to

- another person and engages in the conduct despite the risk and without adequate justification;
