The Sydney to London Marathon will start on 12th April in Sydney and finish the Australian stage in Perth on 22nd April. The European stage starts on 26th April from Ankara finishing on 11th May at Windsor in London. The Australian stage is 6651 kl and the European stage a little longer at 7371 kl.
