

TARGA TASAMANIA 2014

Two BLCC crews travelled to Tasmania for the 23rd running of this iconic event known as the ultimate tarmac rally. The mighty 1980 Jaguar XJS, Car 626 from Mullion Creek driven by Mark Hammond with Gordon Lennox riding shotgun was accompanied by Targa Tasmania virgins John Paine and Andrew Crowley in the 1982 Mitsubishi Starion.

As usual the fun started with two prologue stages being Kayena near Beaconsfield followed by the George Town street stage. Mark Hammond succeeded in getting on the party tape by spinning the Jag in front of the VIP tent whilst John started more sedately.

Leg 1 was run over 8 stages north west of Launceston on a fine sunny day with Mark already showing good pace to finish the day 12th in Classics out of 50 starters whilst John was feeling his way back in 39th.

Leg 2 headed to the East coast starting with Rossarden, Elephants Pass then 5 stages on or near the Tasman Highway before the final street stage at Longford. Painey wound up the Starion in Elephants Pass to get his heart racing finishing only 6 seconds slower than Car 627 a 1979 Ferrari 308 GTB and for the remaining stages posted similar times to Car 615 the 1981 Porsche 911 SC which finished the Leg only 1 second ahead. Mark and Gordon moved up to 9th in the Classics after they posted a very quick 3rd quickest time on the short Ledgerwood stage.

Leg 3 out of Launceston saw crews head north then down the west coast to an overnight stop at Strahan. The Hammond Jag was now regularly setting top 10 times whilst the Starion was running soundly being quick in the tight but falling behind more powerful cars on the straights despite fitting a 3.9;1 final drive ratio before the event. Paine and Crowley were gaining valuable experience and finished the day 33rd gaining over 2 minutes on the Porsche 911 (car 615) which had hounded them in Leg 2. Painey had now moved into the lead of Class 6D. The Hammond Jag moved up 2 spots to finish the day 7th behind a brace of Porsche Carreras, 2 RX7s, a Jensen CV8 and the classic leader; Craig Haysman in his rapid Triumph V8 powered TR7. The Hammond service crew of David Catt and Martin McLaughlin had carried out repairs to the Jags exhaust manifold which had burnt a hole in one extractor.

Crews woke on the morning of Leg 4 in Strahan to the wet roads that would see a lot of drama throughout the day. Whilst Paine and Crowley were nervous about racing on wet bitumen they decided to attack due to both having a lot of experience on slippery gravel roads. On the 20 km Murchison stage through Hellyer Gorge, Painey posted a time only 14 seconds slower than the leading Triumph TR7 V8 with the fastest car being 1977 Datsun 260Z being over a minute faster than the top runner! That must have been a scary ride as we constantly fought wheel spin and 4 wheel drifts in the Starion.

The 21 km Riana stage after lunch saw the carnage with 5 Classics going off the slippery road and 6 modern category cars ending up in the trees. The Starion had to be push started before this stage due to some electrical gremlins and saw us start back amongst the faster cars with Mark Hammond right behind us. This may have proved a godsend as several cars ahead speared off with the stricken crews waving us to slow at critical times. The Jag started 30 seconds behind and finished the stage 13 seconds ahead or 43 seconds faster, giving us a great display of the flames shooting out the drivers side exhaust in front of the rear wheels as I eased off to let them pass.

At the end of Leg 4 the Hammond / Lennox Jaguar maintained their 7th position whilst the Paine / Crowley Starion moved up 7 spots to finish the day in 26th. The risks we took had paid off and included an interview in Burnie with the local newspaper. Paine had a comfortable 4:45 gap to the Porsche 911 now and felt comfortable going into the final days run to Hobart although he was keeping a close watch on Andrew Medecke who was making rapid progress several spots back in his V8 Capri after an earlier off.

So, the last day again saw crews set out on wet roads starting with a 33km Strahan stage then a 6.5 km run up and out of Queenstown on the slipperiest bit of bitumen I have ever driven on and it wasn't icey! This was followed by the marathon sting in the tail, a 58km Mt Arrowsmith

stage. Medecke completed Mt Arrowsmith 1 minute faster than the leading Triumph whilst the Hammond Jag was 2:50 faster than the Paine Starion but more importantly faster than one of the Porsches ahead to claim several spots.

The leading Haysman Triumph crashed out of Targa on the penultimate stage as did the Ulrich Jensen who slipped out of contention. Mark Hammond lost a possible 4th Outright to the fast finishing 1969 Holden Monaro GTS of Woodward and Gibson but was happy to finish in 5th in classic which was a great drive in the crowd pleasing Jaguar XJS.

The Paine / Crowley Starion finished 22nd in Classics just holding out the fast finishing Medecke Capri 1:12 behind. Paine and Crowley were over the moon with their result and also won their class ahead of a 1984 Nissan Skyline RS Turbo.

Hammond and Lennox had competed in 3 of the 4 rounds of the Australian Targa Championship finishing 3rd in Classic Outright behind Power and Baker in a Mazda RX7 with a 1974 Porsche 911 RS taking first. They finished 2nd in the Late Classic Championship behind the Power / Baker RX7. Mark once again showed great skill in handling the powerful Jaguar as he steadily moves up the leader board in the challenging environment that is competitive Tarmac Rallying.

Paine and Crowley competed in only 2 of the 4 rounds and finished 14th in the Late Classic Australian Targa Championship.

Doug Barry (Lola) was once again the quickest BLCC member at the fourth round of the NSW Hillclimb Championship held at Tamworth. Doug Barry finished 1st in class and 3rd outright and is equal 2nd outright with Ron Hay in the 2014 championship.

Ron Gallager (Ford Capri) and Phillip Edwards (Mini) both won their classes and Alan Barlow (Austin Healey) was second in his class. All BLCC drivers at Tamworth are leading or second in their classes.

KEENE SHOWS THE WAY AT WAKEFIELD

Three members contested the AASA NSW State Championship at Wakefield Park with Trevor Keene the standout with a pole position and three wins and is 2nd in the 2014 Pulsar Championship. John Markwick is also contesting the championship and lowered his times by almost four seconds and is in the top ten, in 9th in the championship.

Brett McFarland contested the Excel championship and battled the leaders all weekend with a best placing of 2nd and leads the Exel development category.

KING THIRD AT SMP

Tony King (Mazda MX5) finished third in class 6A at State Supersprint Round 2 at Eastern Creek, 10 May 2014. Tony's time of 1.53.92 finished him in 64th outright out of 119 drivers.

STUART AT SMP SOUTH CIRCUIT

Stuart Pennels (Porsche 944) was placed 23rd outright in the Porsche Club NSW / PR Technology Sprint at Sydney Motorsport Park South Circuit. Stuart recorded a time of 1.05.16 placing well in a field of forty nine cars.

RYLSTONE TO VANCOVER IN A MINI

It's a small world, you go to a British car show in Vancouver Canada and what do you find?

Yes you find a Mini Clubman van from Australia and one that won a rally at Rylstone which had some input from club member David King the owner of the beautiful works repclia Mini.
