Officiating at a Club Event

A few things to remember when acting as an official at a club event. First you must sign on and remember to bring your officials passbook. 8.00 am is a good time to sign on. If you don't have an Officials Licence you will have to fill out a Trainee Licence Form. Junior officials must have a parent or guardian sign them in as well. Sign on for Hill Climbs is in the club rooms. Sign on for a Super Sprint is at Tower 3 in the Pit Complex. Find out what time Officials briefing is and make sure you attend this is usually 8.30am to 845am. You will be given your position for the day, a radio if required and other details about the event you will be required to know as officials. Remember to sign the radio out and back in at the end of the event and remember to pick up your lunch and a drink. If you have special diet requirements then you should advise us in the days before or in some cases you may have to bring your own. The lunches cannot be delivered later.

It is advisable to wear:

Long pants and shirt as well as good solid foot wear. You can't attend a fire in a car in shorts, tee shirts and thongs - You too could become casualty.

Also bring a hat with a good wide brim, Fold up chair, Sun screen, Aeroguard Rain coat, Coat or jumper

Note book and pencil to keep details of any incident you may witness as you may be required to fill in a report later.
