#### TREASURERS REPORT:

Eric Thorpe presented a printed report in absence of Treasurer. It was moved Trevor Seaman and seconded by Mick Williamson that the report be accepted and approval be given for accounts to be paid.

#### **QUARRY REPORT:**

Verbal report: both the Motorkhana (Come & Try event) and Khanacross events conducted in November had been successful days with a good roll up of potential members competing in the Motorkhana. The Khanacross proved to be a very dusty day. Members were advised that the Publicity Officer would be liaising with local schools in 2019 to facilitate additional Come & Try Motorkhana's. Kathy Hanrahan noted that the club needed to have some form of tracking as to who had used a One Day Licence, which is a once only use licence, to eliminate any legal issues should an incident occur.

#### **GENERAL BUSINESS:**

• Guests George & Con spoke re their group wishing to compete in a Flying 1/5 event as they had previously. Both gentlemen acknowledged the difficulties with a few of their group and friends of the group during the last event and assured the meeting that they had addressed those issues. Mick Williamson and Wayne Bowden spoke re the last event's post event difficulties, especially with Police pointing out that BLCC was to conduct several multi day weekends as well as the AHC in 2019 and it was not in BLCC best interest to jeopardise any of our events just for one event. The discussion was moved to Committee for further discussion. A suggested date 18 May which is currently set down for Supersprint.

- Members reminded Presentation Night tickets and metal car badges were available
- Rally Tyres Khanacross Motion moved Ian Plenderleith, seconded Scott Sims, to allow Rally Tyres on 4WD vehicles at Khanacross for 2019. All in favour, motion Carried.
- AHC Committee discussion took place with Scott Sims, Bob Lundie-Jenkins & Kevin Brazier volunteering. Suggestions to approach the Officials group early to ensure their ability to attend. Members were confident that if main officials were effective the Club could successfully conduct the event as there was positive input from past organisers that, even with their reduced direct participation in a committee, they would be available to help & assist with tasks throughout the year. Item was moved back to Committee for AHC Committee implementation.
- Scott Sims thanked all officials who attended Speed Weekend. With many competing events for members it had been a hard task to have enough officials.
- There was discussion re the late start for the Supersprint which was caused by timing failure to gain signal. Mountain Straight late start was caused by a lack of power in the Council's power box powerpoint in McPhillamy Park.
- Robert Dean seeking advice as to whether his letter to Committee for attendance at next Committee meeting had been read by Committee and the response to his request. He was advised that, at the time of the meeting it was unclear as to how many of the Committee had actually seen the correspondence, as quite a few were away, for any response to be given. Robert was advised he would receive a response as soon as possible.

#### **2018 SPEED WEEKEND**

The final tarmac event for the 2018 season was held on Saturday November 24<sup>th</sup> with a Conrod Straight Super Sprint and on Sunday 25<sup>th</sup> November with a Mountain Straight Hillclimb and what a way to finish the year with 84 starters for the Super Sprint and 76 starters for the Hillclimb.

Glenn Pro, in his Toyota Supra Coupe, with a combined 91.71, took the overall

win for the weekend with Aiden Hadley in second place on 93.73 in his Nissan 108ST Coupe and in third place, Leigh Costain with a 95.49 in his Subaru WRX.

Competition over the weekend was very close with Harrison Field taking the best overall Junior with a combined best time for the weekend of 113.10, Izak Berrisford in second place





with 128.01 and Jack Macleod in almost a photo finish for third with a 128.13.

A problem with the timing gear on Saturday delayed the start of the event however, competitors were still able to undertake five runs of the course which

used a large section of Conrod Straight and down to the Pit Straight finish line.

Fastest time for the Super Sprint came from Aiden Hadley with a 45.46 with Glenn Pro in second with a best run of 46.12 and Tim Weston in his AMG A45 Hatch in third with a best time of 46.76, all very close finishes.

Getting underway on Sunday in the Mountain Straight Hillclimb again proved problematic for




officials, this time as a consequence of power problems. However, in true
