



HOW TO APPLY FOR/RENEW CONDITIONAL REGISTRATION

{60 Day LOG BOOK TRIAL}

- (1) Read the rules carefully to ensure:
 - (a) that the restrictions and responsibilities are acceptable to you;
 - (b) that you clearly understand the ramifications and consequences of non compliance.
Retain a copy of the rules
- (2) Obtain from RMS and complete the application form for Conditional Registration (RMS 1246) and Historic Vehicle Declaration form (RMS 1259) where annotated.
- (3) Obtain a Pink Slip - from any RMS Authorised Inspection Station. This should include a brake test. Note that a Blue Slip may be required for previously unregistered vehicles (eg. Interstate/overseas vehicles)
- (4) Complete the BLCC member's declaration form at back of enclosed rules, sign and return.
- (5) Forward your completed signed paperwork to the Club Plate Registrar for sign-off as to eligibility under the scheme.
- (6) Once approved/ returned to you, present completed forms together with pink/blue slip to RMS together with payment for processing. The initial cost will include numberplates-thereafter the cost is registration which also includes Green Slip. Further also take a copy of last club plate permit or registration papers together with personal identification. You may be asked for proof of ownership of vehicle if previous registration was not in your name.
- (7) Provide a copy of Conditional Registration documents to Club Plate Registrar as soon as possible.
- (8) Please note it is a Club requirement to have at least Third Party Property Damage insurance however it may be more economically viable to get full comprehensive insurance for a club plated vehicle. (Shannon's, GIO and NRMA have suitable policies).
- (9) Remember, the plates do not belong to you -they always remain the property of the RMS under the auspices of the BLCC.
- (10) Annual renewals will be issued direct from the RMS. Relative forms will again need to be approved and signed off by Club Plate Registrar to facilitate renewal and ensure ongoing scheme suitability and further verify currency of club membership at that time.

RULES FOR THE USE OF VEHICLES ON CONDITIONAL REGISTRATION & THE USE OF “CLUB PLATES”

PART 1 – GENERAL

This document forms the rules and regulations/conditions of The Bathurst Light Car Club. (to be known herein as the BLCC) regarding the 60 Day Log Booked Conditional Registration concession allowed to financial members of a Motor Club by the Road & Maritime Services of NSW (RMS). The BLCC committee shall appoint a member of the Club as a Registrar for administration of the scheme. (Same person as original Conditional Scheme)

The Registrar shall maintain a record/register of all members holding plates, the plate/s details together with details of relative vehicle the relative plate is held against. Completion of the vehicle usage log shall be the sole responsibility of the member in each instance and is to be completed in ink as required by RMS prior to commencement of proposed journey.

N.B. Registration of your vehicle under the scheme nominating BLCC as primary Club will indicate and imply your acceptance of the conditions required to be complied with by you as a member of BLCC as specified hereunder.

PART 2 – ELIGIBILITY

- (a) All vehicles must be a minimum of 30 years old from year of manufacture, the onus of proof of age shall be with the applicant for Conditional Registration. However the final arbiter shall be the Club Registrar.
- (b) All vehicles must comply with registration requirements in country of origin in year of manufacture and in NSW. Vehicle must be maintained in a roadworthy condition at all times when being driven on public roads and comply with relative RMS regulations.
- (c) Conditional Registration applications will only be considered from vehicle owners who are active financial members of the BLCC, reside in NSW and whose subject vehicle is/will be garaged in NSW.
- (d) Vehicles with full roll bars fitted and so used to compete in sanctioned/approved rallies or similar events are not intended to be included in this specific scheme and must use the alternative RMS Rally Registration Scheme.
- (e) All applicants for Conditional Registration shall be handed a copy of these Regulations and Rules. Applicants are required to read and sign the BLCC form attached acknowledging the fact that they fully understand their responsibilities and in doing so agree to abide by these regulations whilst plates are held. This acknowledgement is to be completed before Conditional Registration will be signed off by the Club.

PART 3 – AUTHORISED USAGE

(a) Vehicles covered by Conditional Registration 60 Day Log Book Trial shall /may be used for/on 60 separate calendar days as recorded in advance (in ink) in respective log books. This use is in addition to any Club events specifically identified in the official club calendar of acknowledged events. This detail is contained in the monthly “Blower” and on the website (subsection “b” hereunder).

No other use is permitted.

- (b) Club events shall include but not be limited to:
 - i events as set out in the BLCC events calendar, including displays for Club promotional purposes agreed to by the Club Committee;
 - ii events conducted by other motoring clubs or organisations to which an official invitation has been received and accepted by the BLCC and advised to Club members;

- iii special events for charities and community bodies to which an official invitation or request to attend is received by the Club Committee;
 - iv official events of other clubs to which particular members of our club have been invited. Such events to be listed in our Events Calendar Register.
 - v When attending any such events a copy a document/blower detailing events in club calendar must be carried so as to avoid issues with police in the event of incident.
- (c) Servicing of Vehicles:
 Journeys necessary to the servicing or road testing of vehicles fall within the “Log Book” usage as designated in the log book usage description and form part of that conditional use..

PART 4 – RESPONSIBILITY OF CONDITIONAL REGISTRATION HOLDERS

- (a) All initial enquiries should/may be directed to the Plates Registrar. Individual approaches to the RMS are not encouraged except for attending to initial registration processes (once signed off approved by BLCC Committee) and subsequent renewals (also after sign off by BLCC committee each year).
- (b) Plates are issued to a member of the BLCC Inc. and are not transferable either to another vehicle or to another person in the event of the vehicle being disposed of by the member.
- (c) Plates must be immediately returned to the RMS.
 - i in the event of the sale of the vehicle on which they are issued;
 - ii upon the member’s resignation from the Club;
 - iii upon the member’s failure to remain a financial member within the meaning of the constitution of the Club or on failure to pay any levy that may be constitutionally approved by a duly constituted Club Meeting; Membership must be up to date on the 1st January each calendar year otherwise vehicle is not technically registered for purpose of use on the road.
 - iv at the directive of a Club Committee decision. Particularly concerning any actions deemed prejudicial to the good name and standing of the BLCC;
 - v if the Club Registrar considers the vehicle has been made unsafe or altered after it has been initially inspected and passed.
- (d) Conditional Registration is issued on the understanding that the member’s prime intended use is in accordance with these conditions and not in a manner that would bring ill repute to BLCC in event of incident .

NOTE:

Failure to return your Plates upon request may/will result in immediate notification to the Police and RMS that an unregistered vehicle may be being used from your address. Plates always remain property of RMS under the auspices of the BLCC. Any fee paid is deemed as hiring only and no refund will be given on return of plates for any reason.

PART 5 – ANNUAL VEHICLE INSPECTION

- (a) Please note that the RMS will issue renewals for Conditional Registration through the mail as with normal vehicle registration. All renewals must be signed off by the Club Plate Registrar.
- (b) Each year, you will receive your RMS renewal documents. Please co-operate by actioning renewal by due date indicated. Failure to comply may result in renewal being denied.

- (c) You will need to obtain pink slip and provide insurance details etc annually to the plate registrar.
- (d) No member will be issued with Conditional Registration or renewal if that member's vehicle is found not to be roadworthy or ineligible or modified further to original condition of presentation for initial registration.
- (e) Chassis and engine numbers will form part of the identification of a vehicle issued with Conditional Registration – any change must be notified in writing to the Club Plates Registrar.
- (f) Please ensure you notify any change of your postal address or place where your car is garaged both to RMS and Club Membership Registrar.(Refer website for detail)

PART 6 – INSURANCE REOUIREMENTS

A minimum insurance cover of Third Party Property Insurance is required. Proof of cover must be provided to the Club Registrar before Conditional Registration/or Renewal will be issued/approved. It is strongly recommended that full comprehensive insurance be obtained as a policy on an eligible “Conditionally Registered “vehicle is approximately the same cost as Third Party Property Insurance.

SUPPLEMENT

As the issue of these plates is a concession from the RMS in conjunction with BLCC, applicants are advised to read the attached Rules carefully and at all times comply with their directives. Bear in mind any transgressions could bring the Club into disrepute.

In addition, please note that any car driven on a public road must be properly silenced with a muffler suitable/compliant for road use.

Numberplates issued by the RMS must be attached to both the front and rear of the vehicle whilst being driven on the road.

As the Club(BLCC) must advise the RMS of any vehicle being sold, it is essential that the Club Plate Registrar be immediately informed of any change which may affect the issue of the respective plates.

Please remember that if any use is not “Authorised Use” (ref. Section 3) then the vehicle at the time is not legally covered by the scheme. Owner would/may be denied any insurance cover irrespective of whether CTP, Third Party Property or Comprehensive policies.

(This also applies if you cease to be a financial member of the BLCC.)

All applications for BLCC Conditional Registration must be accompanied by detailed photographs of the above said vehicle to assist the BLCC Historic /Conditional Registration Registrar to evaluate eligibility for historic registration requested. Any changes to the vehicle made after initial approval and / or modifications not divulged at the time of application may render the conditional registration for the vehicle null and void.

BLCC can request the vehicle be presented for inspection at any time during the year should it have reason to believe that the vehicle may have contravened the BLCC’s Rules for the Use of Vehicles on Conditional Registration.

Vehicle modifications

The Club (BLCC) also requires compliance with the rule stating that the vehicle be as close to standard/original as possible but with acceptable variations of period style options and accessories being added to the vehicle as they may have been during the vehicle’s era.

Please list any modifications on a separate sheet noting that vehicles with 6 point roll cages may preclude your vehicle from the 60 Day Log Booked Trial Conditional Registration scheme. Rally Cars should utilize the RMS Rally Registration Scheme.

Vehicle use

I understand that Vehicles can only be used 60 days per year for Log Book trial purposes in accordance with log book conditions- servicing and testing forms part of the 60 days usage. Additionally any BLCC approved events, as detailed in the Official Calendar documented in the Monthly “Blower” and maintained on the website . I declare that I am the bona fide owner of the above vehicle and have read and understand all terms and conditions for BLCC 60 Day Log Booked Trial Conditional Registration Scheme and declare the above said vehicle meets the requirements of the BLCC and RMS guidelines for such Conditional Registration. I also agree to surrender these plates to the RMS if directed by the Club’s committee as a result of serious and deliberate contravention of these guidelines, expiry of registration, or sale of the vehicle or ceasing to be a financial member of BLCC. Further also that trip detail must be recorded in ink prior to commencement of each day/trip.

(NB - this form is to be filled out and sent to the club registrar annually one form per vehicle)
